How many laps does my student run?

Students run for 20 minutes. In order to keep kids moving and distanced, we will not be marking laps this year but rather recording laps based on the national average of 34.

Do all the students run at the same time?

Students will run with their grade level but divided by specials area, amongst several tracks.

Can I come watch?

For everyone's safety and to be in accordance with OCPS policies, spectators are not allowed. However, several volunteer opportunities are available.

What volunteer positions are available?

Volunteer opportunities will be first come, first serve. We will need several Grade Level Volunteers, Photographer Volunteers and Golden Eagle Volunteers.

What is the role of a Grade Level Volunteer (GLV)?

Grade Level Volunteers will be packing our healthy snacks for our runners and delivering to classrooms. They will also be moved outside to help photograph during their assigned grade level run.

What is the role of a Photographer Volunteer (PV)?

Photographer Volunteers will be positioned outside on an assigned track to take photos of all students on the track during the run. Must have their own camera and commit to submitting photos after the conclusion of the event. We cannot guarantee you will be assigned to your student's track but will accommodate where possible.

Is there anything I can donate to help?

MPE PTA and local area businesses will be sponsoring a healthy post run snack. We are seeking donations of bottled water for our runners. If you are able to donate water please have it dropped off in the main office labeled: FUN RUN and the teachers name. Extra water, not used on during the run, will be delivered to the teachers indicated for class use.

I have more than one student running. Can I still volunteer?

You are welcome to volunteer for multiple grade levels, however by signing up for back to back shifts you may not have an opportunity to go to the field. If you want to be by the tracks consider being a Photographer instead of a Grade Level Volunteer
