Description of Helping Hands Needs

Posters, Box Tops or Other at Home Projects – We supply the poster board and markers and give you several posters to create for some of our events like Fun Run, Movie Night, Carnival, etc. Box Tops for Education are turned in by the students weekly. Volunteers take bags home each month to count and verify that they are not expired, then turn them back in for the Fall & Spring submittals each year. Sometimes we have other small projects that can be done at home as well. Great for parents that want to be involved, but have young children at home.

School Beautification – Sat Oct 12th from 8am – noon we have families come to clean up, paint, mulch, trim bushes & replant around the outside of our school to keep it in beautiful condition. We ask families & friends to show up and bring yard tools to help with the process. Great volunteer project for business groups, clubs, or volunteer hours for high school students.

Family Dance – This event is on Feb 14th, but we need parents to help plan our 5th annual Family Dance. A committee reviews last year's process as a guideline – and then just makes some small changes each year to improve what we can. This is a fun event that is always sold out due to limited capacity in our cafeteria. The committee will typically start meeting one night a week from Nov – Jan.

Popcorn Fridays – Need parents to come in either 1 or 2 Friday mornings each month to help pop and distribute bags of popcorn to classrooms. This is a great way to get to know your way around the school and meet the staff. Special Thanks to our Co-chairs Sandy Dininger and . Below is the schedule:

Holiday Shop – We decorate and set up shop on Mon & Tues Nov 18 & 19th, we preview the shop to the classrooms on Wed Nov 20, then we open for sales Thurs Nov 21, 22 and again after Thanksgiving Break from Dec 2 - 6. We also have a night event including photos with Santa on Wed Dec 4 from 4-7. All regular hours are during school and you can sign up for short or long shifts as many days as you want to. We need LOTS of HELPERS to make this event fun for the kids!

Spring Carnival Planning Team – Our 7th Annual Spring Carnival is Friday March 14th from 4-8pm. It is the biggest event of the year with over 125 volunteers needed. We start planning carnival in Dec. We need parents to chair or cochair one of the following: Food, Games, Prizes, Rides, Vendors, Auction, Tickets or Parking.

Teacher/Staff Appreciation –Teacher /Staff Appreciation Week is May 12-16. We plan a variety of meals & fun for the week. We also need help creating & distributing small monthly treats for our staff. If you are a good cook or good at crafts – this would be a plus!

5th Gr. Celebration on Tues June 3rd – Parents of 5th Graders: We need Co-chairs & volunteers for the following committees: Food, Activities, Decorations, & Memory Book/Slideshow. The parents that volunteer to plan the event are the only ones that can attend on the day of the event. Committee meetings start in early March and meet once a week.

Library Helpers – The school needs some extra hands in the mornings to help put away books in our Media Center.

Classroom Helpers – also known as Homeroom Parents. Many teachers want parents to help in the classroom, help with special projects, or help with class parties. (You can help in your own child's classroom)




